Come to our 2010 Convention at Port Chalmers and experience it yourself.

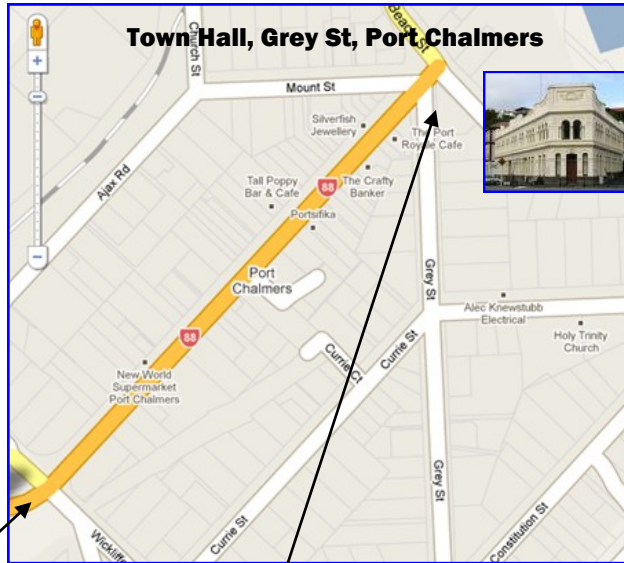
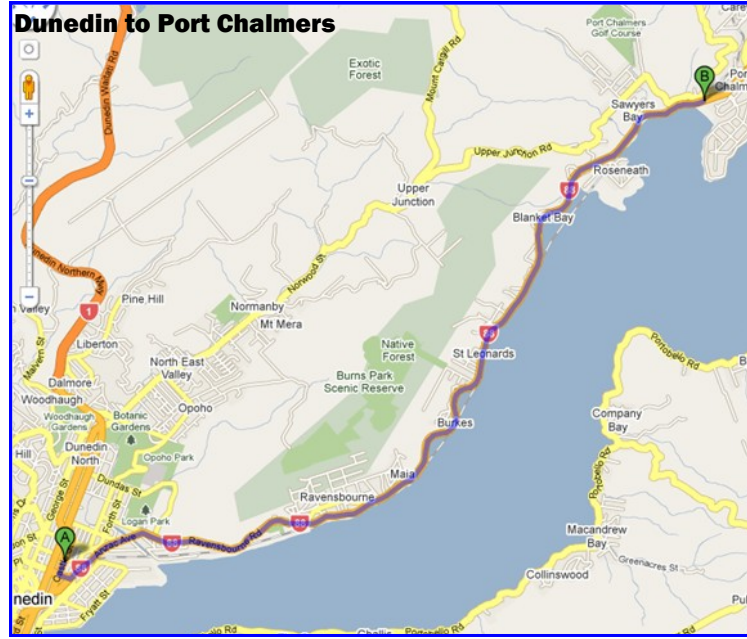
